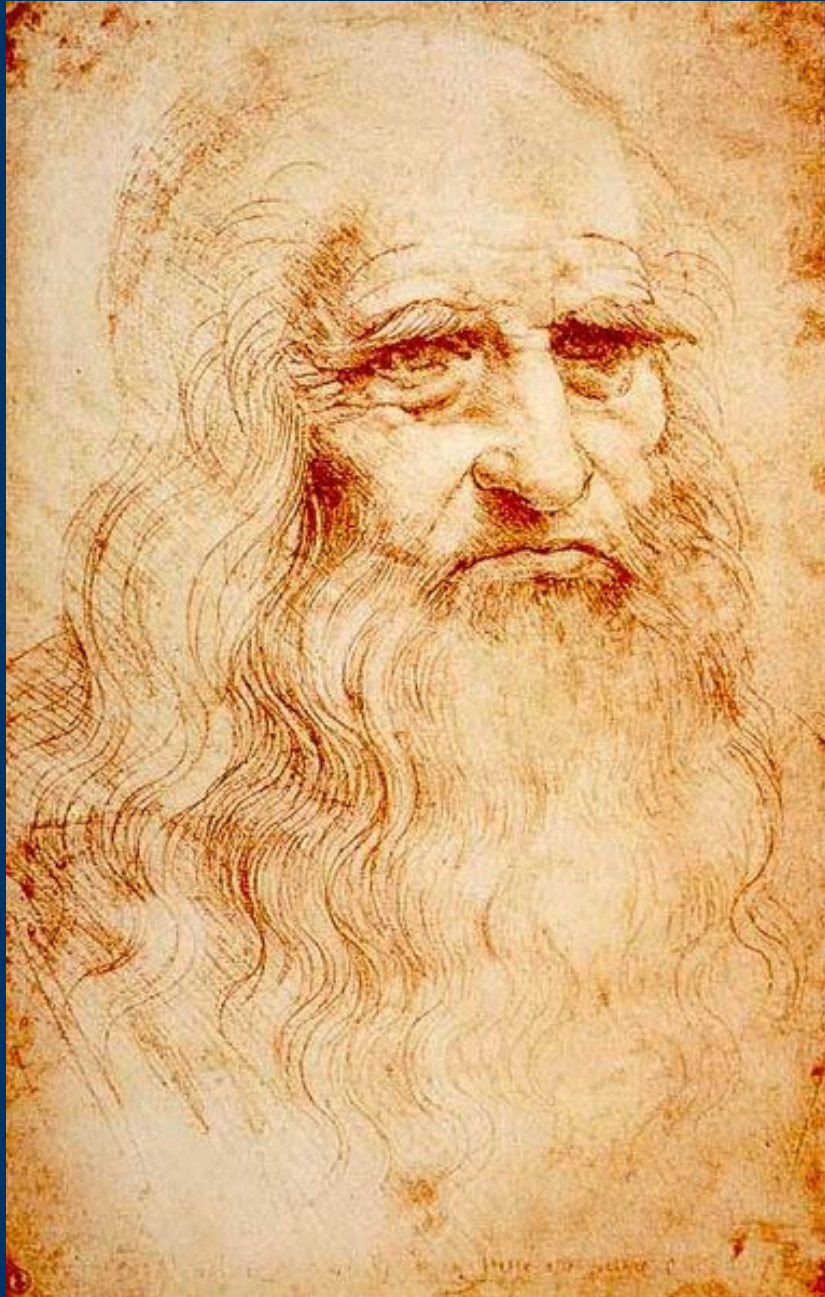


LEONARDO DA VINCI

He was born in Vinci, on the 1452.

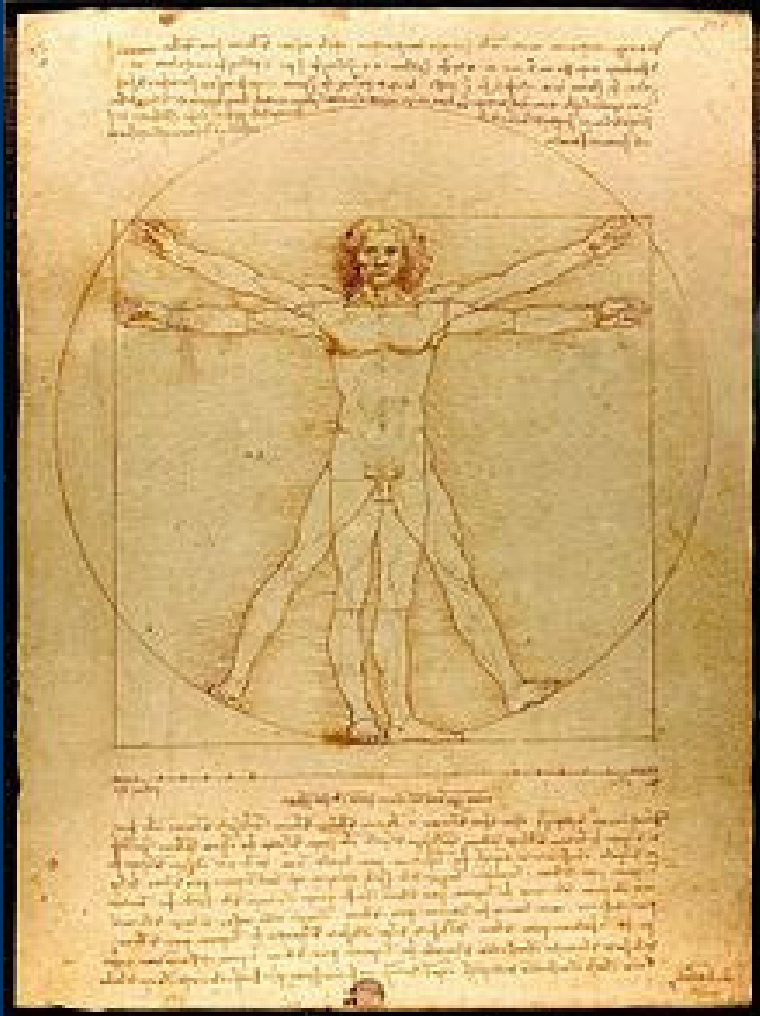
Leonardo was an italian polymath: painter, writer, sculptor, architect, musician engineer, scientist, inventor and also geologist.

In 1466, at the age of fourteen, Leonardo was apprenticed to the artist Andrea di Cione, known as Verrocchio whose workshop was "one of the finest in Florence".

Leonardo was interested in anatomy, he studied the human body also he wrote 13.000 pages, for his projects.

He studied also the fly of bird, because he wanted fly.

Paintings of the 1490s

Leonardo's most famous painting of the 1490s is *The Last Supper*, also painted in Milan.

The painting represents the last meal shared by Jesus with his disciples.



Paintings of the 1500s



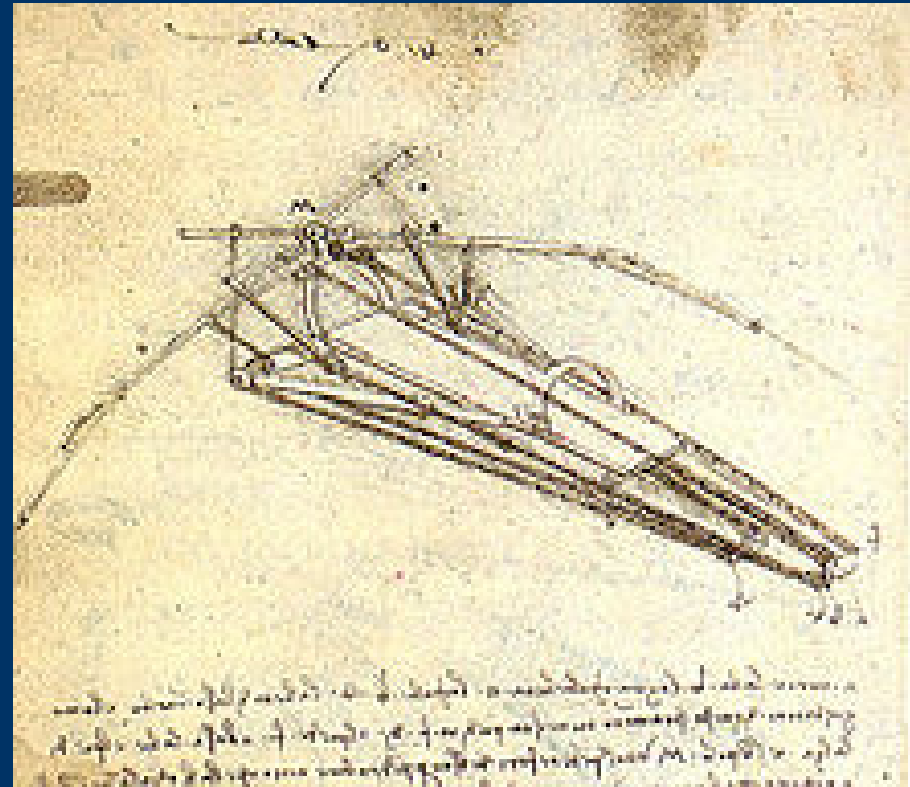
Among the works created by Leonardo in the 16th century there's the Monna Lisa.
