

I attend Dante Alighieri school.

This is a typical school for pupils from 11 to 13.

The school is in Via Pacchiotti and every day (except during the holiday) it starts at 7:55 a.m. and finishes at 1:25 p.m but on Tuesday and on Friday my class finishes school at 4:00 p.m .
